Day 1 June 1, Saturday: Depart USA

Depart New York's JFK International Airport for our pilgrimage to Italy. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D,B,L)

Day 2 June 2, Sunday: Arrive in Rome | Assisi

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit from Customs. Then, board our private coach and we will be on our way to Assisi. A stop will be made en route for independent lunch. After lunch, continue driving through the Umbrian countryside until the mountaintop city of Assisi appears. Assisi is a charming town with narrow cobblestone lanes, medieval architecture, and shrines of St. Francis and St. Clare. Visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli. Crowned by the magnificent dome designed by Alessi, this great Basilica was built in 1569. It enclosed the shrine of the "Porziuncola" or the Little Portion Chapel around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the saint died. See the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. **Celebrate Mass at St. Mary of the Angels.** After Mass, we will check in at our hotel.

Enjoy the balance of the day at leisure to rest or explore the town. For those who wish, you may take a brief orientation walk, led by our tour manager, to become acquainted with some of the main sites, from the Basilica of St. Francis to shops around Piazza Santa Chiara.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (D)

Day 3 June 3, Monday: Sites of St. Francis and St. Clare

Early morning, celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis (subject to confirmation). After Mass, return to our hotel for breakfast. Then, a local guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, which is actually two churches, one built on top of the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 - 1253, you will marvel at the monumental frescoes by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of St. Francis. Continue to the basilica dedicated to St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and spend time in quiet prayer and reflection before the miraculous San Damiano Crucifix. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, our local guide will take us, by taxis, to the Eremo delle Carceri (Hermitage), a few miles outside the town of Assisi, situated on the forest-clad slopes of Mt. Subasio. (Option to celebrate Mass at the Hermitage). This is where St. Francis often retired to pray. Here, in the midst of the lush green forest and the singing birds, one gets a deep sense of the spirit of St. Francis. Time will be given for prayer and reflection. On the way back to Assisi we stop to visit San Damiano, the place where St. Clare lived and died. According to tradition, in this place St. Francis composed the Canticle of Creation. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B)

Day 4 June 4, Tuesday: Siena | Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. Then, board our comfortable motor coach for an excursion to the city of Siena. Siena is self-contained and still rural in parts behind its medieval walls. It is a Gothic city that today can be enjoyed on foot. Upon arrival, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Dominic, where the relic of St. Catherine, the Dominican mystic and patron saint of Italy, may be seen and venerated. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Dominic.** Visit the house where St. Catherine lived, which is now a sanctuary and church. Continue to the center of Siena with its great square, Il Campo, built at the convergence of the city's principal roads: the Banchi di Sopra, Banchi di Sotto, and Via di Città. Now filled with outdoor cafés, Piazza del Campo is the site of the famous Palio horse races. Independent lunch in Siena.

Visit the beautiful Duomo, the Medieval Cathedral of Siena, which was originally designed and completed between 1215 and 1263. It has the form of a Latin cross, with a dome and bell tower. After our visit we'll leave Siena for the "Eternal City". Check in at our hotel upon arrival in Rome.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 5 June 5, Wednesday: Papal Audience | Papal Basilicas

After early breakfast, **enter the heart of Christendom to attend the general audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his**

message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch. Continue our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major Basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem, and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, or Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major.**

After Mass, we'll continue to visit the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the Popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. From there we'll pass by the Holy Stairs (presently closed for renovation). These are said to be the steps on which Christ walked on His way to Pilate's palace. Then, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 6 June 6, Thursday: Tour of the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica

After early breakfast, transfer to the Basilica of St. Peter to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels.

After breakfast, begin our morning of sightseeing with a visit to one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and contemplate the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End your morning tour in St. Peter's Basilica. Independent lunch.

This is your opportunity to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Rome all on your own! Perhaps you will want to treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. There are always plenty of churches, museums, piazzas, and ancient ruins to explore. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 7 June 7, Friday: Tour of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls and the Catacombs

Leisurely breakfast at our hotel followed by a free morning to rest or explore on your own.

This afternoon enjoy a unique tour of Rome and her outskirts. Drive past Tiberina Island, the Aventine Hill, the pyramid of Caius Cestius, and St. Paul's Gate, part of the ancient Aurelian Wall. Stop to visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope throughout history. Then, drive along a section of the Old Appian Way, one of the first ancient Roman military roads that connected Rome to Naples and Brindisi on the Adriatic coast. You can see the huge slabs that originally paved its length and several surviving Patrician tombs that once lined its way, including the massive tomb of Cecilia Metella. Visit the Catacombs, the maze of tunnels hollowed out of volcanic rock, where early Christians secretly practiced their religious rites and buried their dead. **Celebrate Mass at the Catacombs or at the Basilica of St. Paul.**

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 8 June 8, Saturday: Tour of St. Peter's Basilica

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, transfer to St. Peter's Basilica and take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the new tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. On your own, with time permitting, you may wish to go to the Vatican Crypt to see and pray near the tomb of St. Peter. **Celebrate Mass at one of the Grotto Chapels in St. Peter's Basilica.**

Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure to enjoy Rome on your own. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 9 June 9, Pentecost Sunday: Papal Mass | Festive Group Dinner

After an early breakfast, we will be transported to St. Peter's Square for the 10:00 a.m. Papal Mass for the Solemnity of Pentecost, celebrated by His Holiness Pope Francis. After Mass, attend the noon Papal Blessing in St. Peter's Square. Independent lunch.

Enjoy a farewell dinner at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship, and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 10 June 10, Monday: Return to the USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents, including passport.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on Alitalia Airlines from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Additionally, if you purchase any connecting airfare and the group does not materialize, or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for cost of this airfare.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (\$3,050.00 per person sharing a twin room) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds with private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed, an additional charge of \$795.00 will apply. We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus five (5) dinners, including a festive farewell dinner in Rome.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities to the tour manager, guides, and driver are not included in the package price. \$80.00 per person will be added to each participant's final invoice to cover tips in Italy. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others.
