

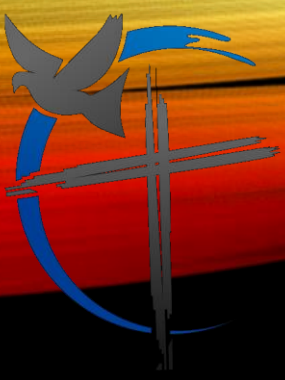

Amen. Alleluia.



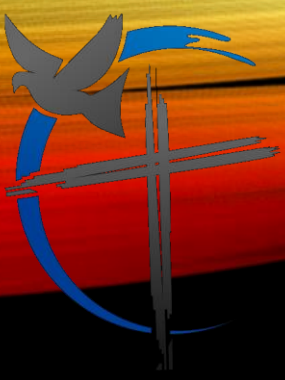


SESSION 2: QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

 - 3) at the center and Lord of your life?

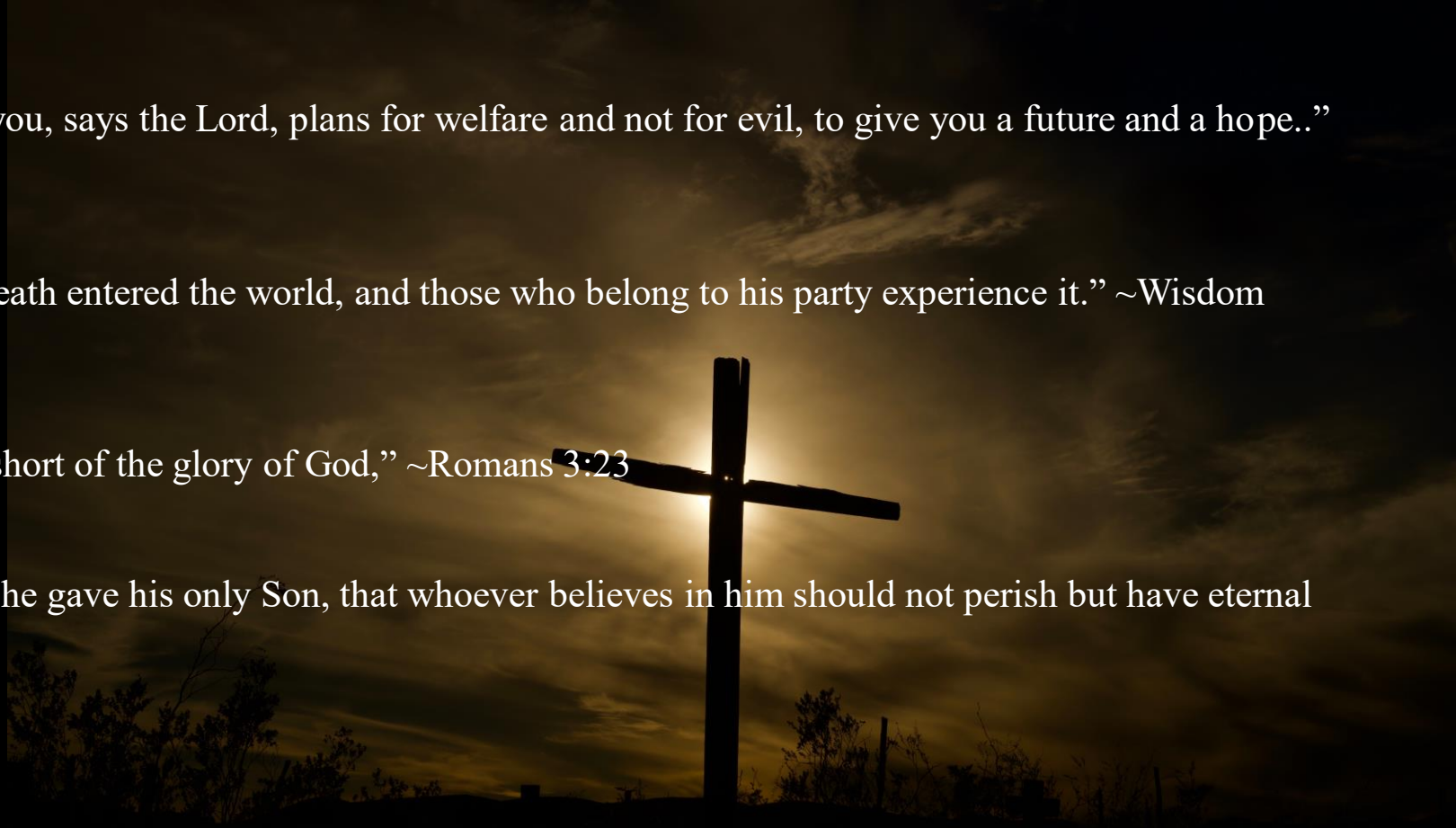

DAILY SCRIPTURE READINGS

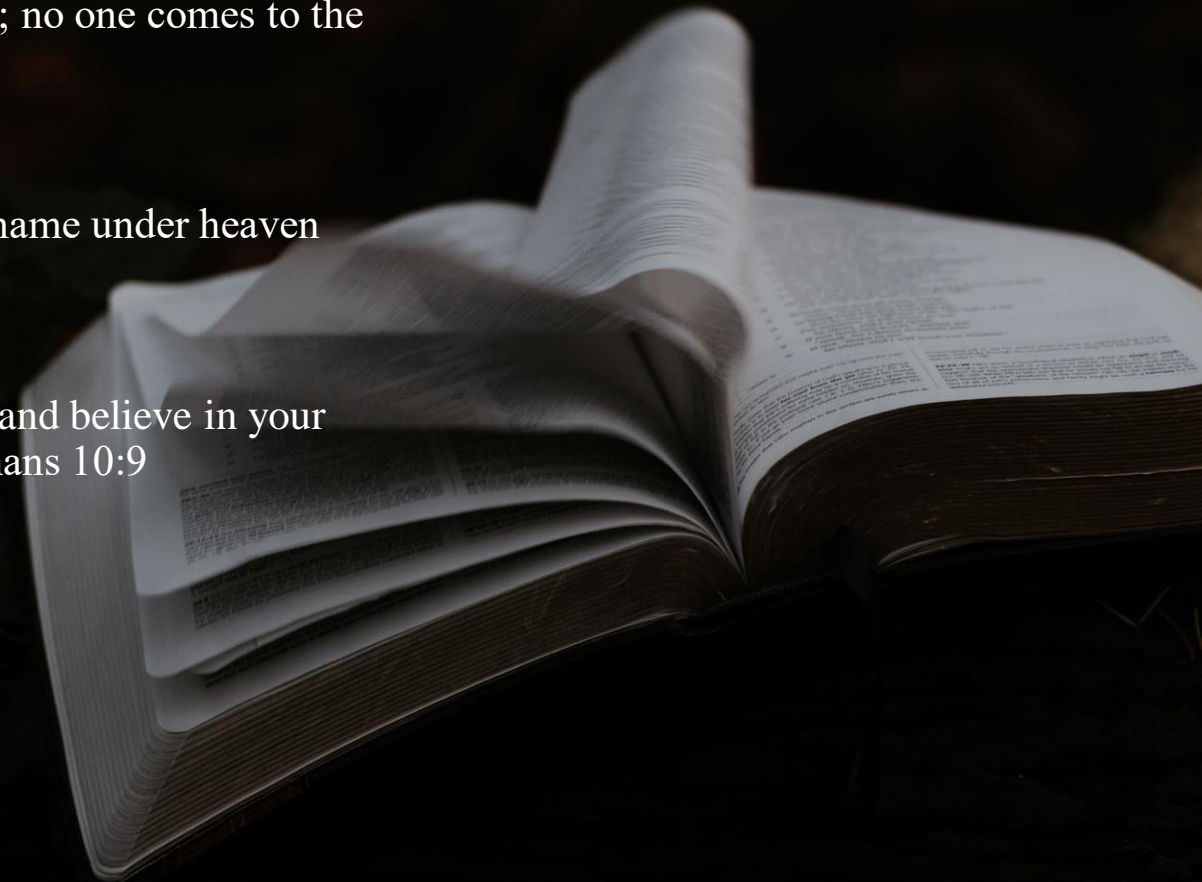
- Day 1: “For I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope..” ~Jer 29:11

- Day 4: “For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.” ~John 3:16

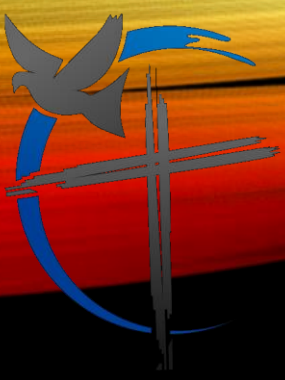




DAILY SCRIPTURE READINGS (CONT.)
